Choosing a Shipping Carrier for Your Canadian Shipments

Evaluating Carriers on Shipping Costs

There are many carrier options to choose from when shipping packages to your customers in Canada. Remember, based on the carrier you select, you might pay additional fees and surcharges. GlobalPost does not include any extra fees to deliver packages to Canadian destinations.

Evaluating Carriers on End-to-End Delivery

FedEx handles package delivery from the sender in the U.S. to the recipient in Canada. On the other hand, GlobalPost handles the package up to customs, after which the package is handed over to Canada Post to handle delivery to the recipient.



GlobalPost Shipping Options

If you are shipping your packages to Canada using GlobalPost, you can choose from several mail classes based on cost and delivery speed.

Shipping to Canada with GlobalPost Standard

How much does it cost to ship GlobalPost Standard International to Canada?

GlobalPost enables businesses to ship international parcels fast and affordably, saving you time and money. Our partnerships with global postal carriers and our software-based network allows flexibility, ensuring you get the best service at the lowest rates with every shipment. GlobalPost operates out of eight strategically located processing facilities in the U.S. to ensure your shipments are processed and transported to its final destination in the shortest amount of time possible and at the lowest rates.

Duties, Taxes and Tariffs

In most cases, your Canadian buyer is responsible for duties, taxes and tariffs that are imposed on imported goods. It is important you communicate these additional fees to your customers at checkout to avoid unpleasant surprises at the time of package delivery.



Duties and Taxes

Goods and Services Tax:

There are 3 kinds of duties and taxes for items being imported into Canada:

- Goods and Services Tax (GST): This is a 5% federal tax that applies to items being sold to Canadian customers for domestic consumption.
- 2. Harmonized Tax (HST): A handful of Canadian provinces have opted to harmonize their provincial sales tax with the general sales tax and the total rate is known as Harmonized Tax.
- 3. Provincial Sales Tax (PST): Provinces that do not participate in the HST collection process impose their own taxes at the local level. The tax rate varies by province and can range from 5% to 9.75%.

Duties Delivered Paid (DDP) vs Duties Delivered Unpaid (DDU)

Depending on the option you choose there could be extra fees to pay at the door.

Some carriers allow shippers the option to pay duties and taxes in advance (DDP) or deliver the package with taxes paid by recipient (DDU). DDU shipments typically include a service fee upwards of \$9.95 CAD in addition to the duties and taxes.

The United States Postal Service supports DDU only. GlobalPost offers DDU services via Global-Post Standard and GlobalPost Economy, and DDP services via GlobalPost Plus.

Tariffs

Along with duties and taxes, your Canadian customer may also need to pay tariffs.

Tariffs depend on the country of manufacture, not the country from where the product is purchased. NAFTA eliminates tariffs on all goods that are manufactured in the U.S. and shipped to Canada. However, if your product includes components that were manufactured outside the U.S., then your Canadian customer will need to pay tariffs on those components.

What Products Cannot Be Imported Into Canada?

Before you decide to open your shop to Canadian customers, make sure you aren't selling anything that is prohibited or restricted from being imported into Canada. Here are some examples of these items:
